

Setting Up an iPhone for MyCloud Exchange

Setting up your Apple iPhone for access to MyCloud Exchange is straightforward and easy.

If you are familiar with how to set up an Exchange service on the iPhone, here are the settings you will need:

Email	Your full email address (e.g. my.name@mydomain.com)
Server	exchange.ecloudserv.net
Domain	ELOUDSERV
Username	Your full email address (e.g. my.name@mydomain.com)
Password	[as specified]
Description	MyCloud Exchange
Use SSL	On
S/MIME	Off

Here is how to set-up your iPhone for an Exchange service:

1. Tap **Settings > Mail, Contacts, Calendars > Add Account**.
2. Tap **Microsoft Exchange**.
3. You don't need to enter anything in the **Domain** box. Enter the information requested in the **Email**, **Username** and **Password** boxes. You need to enter your full email address in the **Email** and **Username** boxes (for example, my.name@mydomain.com).
4. Tap **Next** on the upper-right corner of the screen. Your iPhone will try to find the settings it needs to set up your account. Go to step 6 if your iPhone finds your settings.
5. If your iPhone can't find your settings, you'll need to manually enter your Exchange ActiveSync server name. In the **Server** box, enter your server name from the table above, and then tap **Next**.
6. Choose the type of information you want to synchronise between your account and your device, and then touch **Save**. By default, Mail, Contacts and Calendar information are synchronised.
